2021 Registration Packet

**Please note that some of the below polices are being changed in order to meet the current needs of a modified program due to COVID-19. Updated policies and operating procedures will be emailed out to all participants prior to the commencement of class.

Registration Forms and Payment: To register please visit <u>http://www.indianladderfarms.com/barn-school/</u> to print out and complete: 1) enrollment form 2) medical & liability release form 3) media release permission and 4) code of conduct, and submit them in person, via mail, fax, or email (indicated at the top of each page). All these forms can be found in one PDF on the website. Payment can be completed on the online farm market store (<u>https://indian-ladder-farms.square.site/shop/barn-school/10</u>). Upon receipt of online payment and completed registration forms, a confirmation email along with a receipt for tax purposes will be sent to you within a weeks' time. ***Enrollment will only be guaranteed with accepted payment and is on a first come, first served basis. If a program is full, you will be given the option to be put on the waiting list, switch to another session, or cancel your registration. For questions and/or assistance e mail education@indianladderfarms.com.

Refund Requests: Once payment has been received, if you choose to cancel your child's enrollment, a request must be submitted in writing three weeks before the start of the session for a refund minus a \$20.00 processing fee. If the student withdraws less than three weeks before the start of the session, a credit, (but no refund), will be given minus a \$20.00 processing fee. Full refunds are being given due to unprecedented concerns over COVID-19. Refund requests will be determined and processed on a case-by-case basis.

Canceled Classes: We do not like to cancel any sessions on our end; however, each session must be selfsupporting. We have established a minimum enrollment number and will need to cancel any sessions that do not meet this minimum. If we must cancel your chosen session, we will contact you regarding other available sessions. There will be no processing fees involved if we ask you to change sessions or cancel enrollment.

Dropping Off and Picking Up: Barn School morning sessions run Monday to Friday from 9 am to 12 pm and afternoon sessions are from Monday to Friday 1 pm to 4 pm. Please do not drop participants off prior to the class's start time. If participants are taking both a morning and afternoon class, arrangements can be made with Barn School administrators for care between 12 pm and 1 pm.

Weather: In the event of rain, participants will still need to be outside to do farm activities. All participants should be prepared with a raincoat if needed. We cannot give refunds due to inclement weather.

Clothing: For programs that deal with farm animals, participants should bring size-appropriate rubber boots and work gloves labeled with their names on the first day of Barn School. These items can be left in the Barn during the session and brought home at the end of the week. For programs that do not deal with farm animals, participants should wear hiking boots or sneakers that can get dirty. In the event of rain, participants should bring raincoats.

Sun and Insects: Please wear a hat, apply sunscreen and insect repellent prior to arriving at The Barn School.

Refreshments: The Barn School will provide participants with a mid-morning and mid-afternoon snack and cold beverage. Although food allergies are listed on the medical form please confirm that the instructor is aware if a participant has any food allergies. Participants are advised to bring their own water bottles and will have plenty of opportunities to refill them as needed.

Thank you for choosing to spend your summer with us at Indian Ladder Farms. We are a private, family-owned farm that is open to the public and during regular hours of operation invites guests onto the property. To ensure a safe and enjoyable farm experience for all, we require a certain level of good behavior, respect, and compassion towards fellow Barn Schoolers, Instructors, Assistants, ILF Staff, and Animals always. In addition, Barn School participants are expected to partake in the scheduled activities along with the rest of their group, unless previous arrangements have been made with parents or guardians, staff provided to adequately supervise participant and enough advanced notice has been given.

If a participant is found to be in violation of this code of conduct, a verbal warning will be given out. If violations persist, the student may be required to sit out of the activities for a given amount of time or the remainder of the session, and the parent will be notified upon pick up. If violations continue after that, said student may not be allowed to return to The Barn School with no refund of tuition. When misbehavior or disrespect towards people or animals is severe, parents will be called and immediate dismissal from the property will be required. Violations of this code of conduct may also jeopardize admission to future programs. Parents and guardians are expected to work with staff and management to help resolve any behavior problems that arise during The Barn School and are ultimately responsible for the actions of their child.
